Definitions of political geography, scope of subject matter and basic concepts related to political geography. State, territory, political border - definitions, functions, classifications and influence on contemporary political and socio-economic phenomena and processes. Non-sovereign territories; modern dependent territories; para-states political division of seas and oceans and airspace. Spatial distribution of armed conflicts in the world. Hotspots and issues as potential causes of armed conflict. National and religious diversity in the world and its consequences. Electoral geography. Changes in the political map of the world.
